D. DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION ITEMS:

- 1. Maricopa County Sheriff's Office vehicle request.

Capt. Tim Campbell, District 1 Commander, submitted a written request for the town's consideration for the purchase of a vehicle for the exclusive use of the town liaison. The town liaison is assigned a district vehicle to perform his duties as the liaison to the town, however, due to a shortage of district vehicles it is no longer possible to assign a vehicle solely to the liaison. An estimate of \$65,580 for a fully equipped 2011 Chevy Tahoe was provided for council's review and consideration.

It was the consensus of the Mayor and Council not to purchase a vehicle for the sheriffs at this time.
