Mr. Hernandez reported on the town's efforts to develop the north east corner of Guadalupe Road and Avenida del Yaqui bringing in retail and creating the opportunity tax credits available to Pascua Yaqui Tribe. Development will include a supermarket and retail businesses and possibly development endeavors by the Cardinals east of the Mercado.
