Crazy 8's Math Club, Series 1, grades K-2 and grades 3-5

School Age. It's time to get crazy with math at your Guadalupe Branch Library! For 8 weeks, we will be experiencing math in fun and wacky ways! Prepare to build, toss, get a little messy and more during this math hour. This is not your ordinary after school math club, so sign up and let's get crazy! All materials provided. *Registration required.*

PYT Preschool Storytime

Ages 3-5. Storytime designed for preschoolers, performed during the afterschool tutoring program at the Pascua Yaqui Tribe Administration building. After storytime, children will have an opportunity to use a LaunchpAd. *This device was purchased with federal funds from the Institute of Museum and Library Services, through the Arizona State Library, Archives & Public Records, a division of the Secretary of State. This program will be held at 9405 S. Avenida del Yaqui, Guadalupe, AZ 85283.*

Bilingual Storytime

Ages 0-5. Bilingual storytime designed for pre-readers, focusing on improving literacy skills. This program features books and a variety of activities such as puppetry, dramatics, flannel boards, music and more.

Lego Club

Ages 6 and up. Lego Club is open to all school-age children and their siblings. Choose to construct a Lego Mindstorm Track3r, or continue help us finish Hogwarts Castle from Harry Potter. Snacks will be provided.

Teen Court Club

Ages 13-17. Join local teens in this club to learn answers to legal questions, gain leadership skills and learn about the law. Teens will also have the opportunity to network with professionals, prepare for college and earn community service hours. *Sponsored by the Guadalupe Municipal Court.*

Young Innovators Club

Tweens/Teens. Participants will have the opportunity to tinker with toys, technology gadgets, and other items to apply practical skills and create. *Registration required.*

Read & Feed

Ages 0-17. Returning to this year's Maricopa County Reads! Summer Reading Program at the Guadalupe Branch Library, children 0-17 may read some books and earn badges while eating free lunch at this branch location. *This service is funded by St. Mary's Food Bank Alliance and Summer Food Service Program USDA.*

Ready, Set, Go...Kindergarten Here We Go!

Preschoolers. *Ready, Set, Go...* focuses on preschool and early elementary children and their parents. The program will prepare participants for kindergarten and introduce them to technology as a learning tool by using a multi-touch, interactive SMART Table. Preschoolers will engage in active discussions, problem solving and small group collaboration activities. *This program is supported by the Arizona State Library, Archives & Public Records, a division of the Secretary of State, with federal funds from the Institute of Museum and Library Services thru an LSTA Grant.*
