Town of Guadalupe launches COVID-19 Responses Team

Guadalupe, AZ - The Town of Guadalupe is experiencing a COVID-19 positive case rate that is four times the rate of Maricopa County, according to the Maricopa County Public Health Department. To combat this outbreak, the Town of Guadalupe recently established a Guadalupe COVID-19 Response Team, in partnership with the Pascua Yaqui Tribe, Maricopa County Public Health Department and Arizona State University. This partnership will share resources to reduce the virus spread, assist in recovery of individuals who tested positive and promote guidance from the CDC, Department of Labor, Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA,) and Arizona Department of Health Services to mitigate the spread of COVID-19. This includes:

- Promoting healthy hygiene practices;
- Promoting physical distancing between people;
- Providing face coverings as supplies last;
- Sharing information about proper cleaning, disinfection and ventilation practices; and
- Encouraging residents to stay at home when sick.

“On behalf of the Town, we appreciate the cooperation of the response team partners. Through our collective efforts and resources, we will work to improve the health of Guadalupe residents to reduce the number of COVID-19 positive cases.” stated Mayor Valerie Molina. “
