 - 2. The Education and youth Programs Committee will present and ask Council to appoint new members and or a new chair to the Committee and remove prior members.
 - 3. Council will take action to consider allowing the Education and Youth Committee to use budgeted funds and submit invoices to the Town and will consider providing a budget for Dia del Nino activities as presented by Normalicia Blanco. After providing proper documentation vendors will be paid by the Town of Guadalupe.
 - 4. Council will consider making a onetime contribution of some dollar amount to the Guadalupe/Tempe Little League for the use of paying fees for participants that are unable to afford them. This one contribution will be contingent on the League seeking help from other nonprofits or others to obtain the 501©3 status so that in future years they will be able to solicit needed funds from local businesses.
 - Should funding be approved they will be paid out by the Town based on a voucher system whereas the participant will need to fill out the appropriate paper work that will be approved by the CAP office staff and then paid to the league based on those vouchers.
 - 5. Council will take action to cancel the Regular Town Council meeting scheduled for February 9th, 2017.
