The purpose of this report is to provide brief information regarding each of the meeting's agenda items.

#### **Agenda Items:**

- D1. AUGUST 12, 2021, REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES. (PAGES 6 12)
- G1. COVID-19 UPDATE (MATERIAL WILL BE PROVIDED AT THE MEETING): Staff will provide an update regarding current Town of Guadalupe COVID-19 positive case rates, scheduled testing, vaccination information, Town service and steps taken to safeguard public health and safety in response to the Coronavirus.
- G2. SPECIAL EVENT LIQUOR LICENSE REQUEST (PAGES 13 17): The Arizona Department of Liquor Licenses and Control requires local municipalities to forward a recommendation of approval, denial, or no recommendation for Special Event Liquor License applications. The American Legion Post 124 Guadalupe Veterans, a non-profit organization has filed a Special Event Liquor License application with the Arizona Department of Liquor Licenses and Control. The Applicant is Ralph A. Cota on behalf of the American Legion Post 124 Guadalupe Veterans. The event is scheduled for Saturday, October 16, 2021, 7:00 PM – 11:00 PM at the Mercado de Guadalupe (patio), 9201 South Avenida del Yaqui, Guadalupe, AZ. Maricopa County Sheriff's Office personnel will provide event security and the Post will provide age identification verification for alcohol consumption. This is a fundraising dance for the Post, where approximately 60 people are expected to attend.
- G3. AVENIDA DEL YAQUI STREET IMPROVEMENT PROJECT ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION PAYMENT (PAGES 18 - 34): Council will consider and may take action to concur with the construction bid amount and approve a payment in the amount of \$1,011,362 to the Arizona Department of Transportation for the Avenida del Yaqui Street Improvement Project. The revised estimated total project cost is \$6,612,882, which is an increase of \$1,011,362 because of the August 16, 2021, construction bid amount.

The original total project cost was \$5,601,520; of which Federal funds total \$5,282,233; and the Town was responsible for 5.7% (\$319,287) of the project cost. Per the adopted May 31, 2019, intergovernmental agreement (IGA) (#2 g. page 3 of 9) between the Town of Guadalupe and the State of Arizona, Department of Transportation (ADOT), the Town is responsible for the difference between estimated and actual costs, if applicable. Concurrence and approval of this \$1,011,362 amount fulfills this IGA provision.

ADOT requires a decision by September 3, 2021, for this project to proceed on current schedule.

Project background: the following table summarizes the estimated project costs as identified in the original IGA and the IGA amendment, and the 5.7% amount which is the responsibility of the Town. Both the June 4, 2019 IGA, and February 25, 2021, IGA amendment are included for reference.

**Current Project Fiscal Status:** The August 16, 2021, construction bid amount received by ADOT increases the construction costs by \$1,011,362. In discussions with ADOT project managers, the increased cost is due primarily to increased materials and labor costs overall, and driveway, sidewalk stained concrete, and benches costs. To note, only one bid was received by ADOT for the Avenida del Yaqui project and only three construction firms requested the project bid package.

The table below summarizes the Town's financial responsibility due to the increased construction cost and the overall total project cost.

#2 g. (page 3 of 9) After receipt of FHWA authorization, proceed to advertise for, receive and open bids award and enter into a contract with the firm for the construction of the Project. If the bid amounts exceed the construction cost estimate, obtain Town concurrence prior to awarding the contract. After the Project is awarded, invoice the Town for the difference between estimated and actual costs, if applicable.

As a result, the Town's overall project responsibility increased from 5.7% to 20.1%.

**Fiscal Options:** Presently, \$152,680 is approved as the part of the adopted FY 2021/2022 budget in the Highway User Revenue Fund (HURF). As a result, \$1,011,362 - \$152,680 = \$858,682. Therefore, \$858,682 in additional funds must be identified for the increased project costs.

**Recommendation:** Option D with Option C as a contingency is recommended by the Town Manager. While this construction cost estimate unfortunate, Avenida del Yaqui needs renovation. The condition of the pavement, sidewalk, curb, and gutters continues to deteriorate. The patchwork approach of maintaining the roadway is no longer sustainable. The \$5.2M federal grant available through this process provides the resources for improving Avenida del Yaqui.

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# Minutes Town Council Regular Meeting August 12, 2021

Minutes of the Guadalupe Town Council Regular Meeting held on Thursday, August 12, 2021, at 6:00 P.M., at Guadalupe Town Hall, 9241 South Avenida del Yaqui, Museum Room, Guadalupe, Arizona.

A. Mayor Molina called the meeting to order at 6:06 p.m.

#### B. ROLL CALL

Councilmembers Present: Mayor Valerie Molina and Councilmember Joe Sánchez. The following Councilmembers participated via video conference: Vice Mayor Ricardo Vital, Councilmember Mary Bravo, Councilmember Gloria Cota, and Councilmember Elvira Osuna

Councilmember Absent: Councilmember Anita Cota Soto

Staff Present: Jeff Kulaga – Town Manager / Clerk, Jennifer Drury – Assistant to the Town Manager, Cachi Castorena, MCSO Deputy and, (via video conference) Wayne Clement, Fire Chief and David Ledyard – Town Attorney

#### C. INVOCATION/PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE:

Councilmember Bravo provided the invocation. Mayor Molina then lead the Pledge of Allegiance.

#### D. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Motion by Vice Mayor Vital to approve agenda items D1 and D2; second by Councilmember Osuna. Motion passed unanimously on a voice vote 6-0.

- 1. Councilmembers approved the May 20, 2021, Town Council/Pascua Yaqui Tribe Joint Meeting Minutes.
- 2. Councilmembers approved the July 14, 2021, Town Council Regular Meeting Minutes.
- E. CALL TO THE PUBLIC: No one spoke. Mayor Molina announced that Town Hall is open and that the public is welcome to address the Council in person or via e-mail.

#### F. MAYOR and COUNCIL PRESENTATIONS

Mayor Molina read a proclamation declaring August 2021 as Child Support Awareness Month in the Town of Guadalupe.

#### G. DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION ITEMS:

## 1. GANG PREVENTION OFFICER INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT (RESOLUTION NO. R2021.20)

Mayor Molina stated that this agenda item is to consider authorizing the Mayor, or designee, to enter into an intergovernmental agreement (IGA – C2021-53) with the Tempe Elementary School District, Tempe Union High School District, to jointly fund a Gang Prevention Officer position to mentor at-risk

The term for this position will be five-years with Guadalupe providing funding not to exceed \$30,000 annually.

Jeff Kulaga, Town Manager / Clerk, stated that this is an intergovernmental agreement (IGA) between two school districts and the Town of Guadalupe to jointly fund a Gang Prevention Officer (Officer) position for a five-year period. The Officer would serve the schools as well as the Town of Guadalupe students. The final version of the IGA is pending. Staff is recommending that this agenda item be continued to a future meeting.

In response to a question, Mayor Molina stated that the Pascua Yaqui Tribe is not included in the IGA partnership. The Town and each of the school districts will fund the Officer's salary. There may be upcoming opportunities to partner with the Pascua Yaqui Tribe who may be able to provide funding for special programs related to gang prevention. The school districts may also apply for gaming grant funding from the Pascua Yaqui Tribe.

In response to a question regarding whether the Maricopa County Sheriff's Office is providing data on gang activity that supports the IGA, Mayor Molina stated that the Maricopa County Sheriff's Office has indicated that they would like to be included in the process. Mayor Molina stated that she has contacted various community members that may have an interest in applying for the Gang Prevention Officer position or know someone who might be a good fit for this opportunity.

Mr. Kulaga stated that staff could share the final draft of the IGA with the Pascua Yaqui Tribe and will follow up with MCSO on gang violence data.

Motion by Councilmember Bravo to continue agenda item G1 to a future meeting date; second by Councilmember Cota. Motion passed unanimously on a voice vote 6-0.

Councilmembers continued consideration of adopting Resolution No. R2021.20 to a future Regular Council Meeting date.

## 2. PUBLIC HEARING – BUSINESS LICENSE TAX ORDINANCE AMENDMENT RELATED TO BAR AND LIQUOR STORE APPLICATION, ISSUANCE, AND ANNUAL FEES (ORDINANCE NO. O2021.02)

Mayor Molina stated that this agenda item is to hold a public hearing to receive public input to amend the Town Code of Ordinances, Chapter 111 Business License Tax, Section § 111.08 Fees, Subsection (B) Liquor by adding Series 06 Bar liquor license and Series 09 Liquor Store license. The proposed ordinance would also add application, issuance, and annual fees for the Series 06 Bar and 09 Liquor Store licenses and add the liquor license series number to existing liquor licenses in Section § 111.08 Fees, Subsection (B) Liquor in the Town Code of Ordinances.

Jeff Kulaga, Town Manager / Clerk, stated that the public hearing is to receive public input regarding amending the Town Code to add a Series 06 Bar and Series 09 Liquor Store license types and application, issuance, and annual fees. This is a refinement of the existing Town Code requirements. No public input has been received on this agenda item.

Motion by Councilmember Bravo to open the public hearing; second by Councilmember Osuna. Motion passed unanimously on a voice vote 6-0.

Mayor Molina opened the public hearing. No one spoke.

Motion by Councilmember Bravo to close the public hearing; second by Councilmember Sánchez. Motion passed unanimously on a voice vote 6-0.

Mayor Molina closed the public hearing.

Mayor Molina stated that this agenda item is to consider adoption of Ordinance No. O2021.02 amending the Town Code of Ordinances, Chapter 111 Business License Tax, Section § 111.08 Fees, Subsection (B) Liquor by adding Series 06 Bar liquor license and Series 09 Liquor Store license. The proposed ordinance would also add application, issuance, and annual fees for the Bar and Liquor Store licenses and add the liquor license series number to existing liquor licenses in Section § 111.08 Fees Subsection (B) Liquor in the Town Code of Ordinances.

Jeff Kulaga, Town Manager / Clerk, stated that this is a refinement of the existing Town Code requirements as it relates to Series 06 Bar and Series 09 Liquor Store license types and fees.

Motion by Councilmember Bravo to approve agenda item G3; second by Councilmember Sánchez. Motion passed unanimously on a voice vote 6-0.

Councilmembers adopted **ORDINANCE NO. O2021.02** amending the Town Code of Ordinances, Chapter 111 Business License Tax, Section § 111.08 Fees, Subsection (B) Liquor by adding Series 06 Bar liquor license and Series 09 Liquor Store license. The proposed ordinance would also add application, issuance, and annual fees for the Bar and Liquor Store licenses and add the liquor license series number to existing liquor licenses in Section § 111.08 Fees Subsection (B) Liquor in the Town Code of Ordinances.

#### 4. COVID-19 ACTION UPDATE

Mayor Molina stated that this agenda item is for staff to provide an update regarding current Town of Guadalupe COVID-19 positive case rates, scheduled testing, vaccination information, Town service and steps taken to safeguard public health and safety in response to the Coronavirus.

Jeff Kulaga, Town Manager / Clerk, stated that the July 24, 2021 COVID-19 Vaccination/Back to School event was a success and well attended. 128 people received a vaccination.

The Town's COVID-19 vaccination rate is at 38%. The goal is to have 70% of the Towns' population vaccinated. There is an upcoming vaccination clinic on Saturday, August 14, at the Pascua Yaqui Tribe administration building. The clinic will offer vaccinations, dental screenings, and sports physicals.

There were 17 COVID-19 positive cases in Town last week and 12 this week. Mr. Kulaga reviewed COVID-19 positive case rates in Guadalupe compared to the County positive case rates. He concluded by thanking the Towns' community partners for their ongoing support.

Mayor Molina thanked Tempe School District No. 3 Superintendent Dr. James Driscoll, and Frank Elementary School Principal Jacobo Smith for allowing the Town the use of the Frank Elementary School gymnasium for the Back to School/COVID-19 vaccination event. She then thanked Vice Mayor Vital and the Pascua Yaqui Tribe for coordinating the event.

In response to a question regarding if COVID-19 testing could be added to Saturday's COVID-19 vaccination clinic, Vice Mayor Vital stated that COVID-19 testing will be offered at events later in September. COVID-19 testing requires approval from the County Health Department. It is anticipated

Vaccinations, testing, and flu shot events will be offered in October.

COVID-19 testing for Town residents is available from the Pascua Yaqui Tribe (PYT). PYT is testing approximately 20 people a day for COVID-19. It is unclear if vaccinations will be available at the Spooktacular event. Councilmembers encouraged everyone to get vaccinated and voiced concern about the low vaccination rate in Guadalupe.

#### 5. TOWN-OWNED EXCESS RIGHT-OF-WAY LAND SALE (RESOLUTION NO. R2021.17)

Mayor Molina stated that this agenda item is to consider adoption of a resolution authorizing the sale of Town-owned excess right-of-way. The right-of-way measures 50 feet by 25 feet and operates as a driveway for the adjacent property located at 9000 South Avenida del Yaqui. If approved, the adjacent property owner at 9000 South Avenida del Yaqui would pay the Town of Guadalupe \$9,375 to take ownership of the property, as stated in the Right of Way Agreement (C2021-52). The sale would comply with Arizona Revised Statues sections §28-7205 and §28-7208 declaring the property to be excess, approving the abandonment, and that compensation be paid to the Town.

Jeff Kulaga, Town Manager / Clerk, stated that the Town has an opportunity to sell excess right-of-way (ROW). He displayed an aerial view of the ROW, which is of no use to the Town, but does have value to the adjacent property owner to the west. The adjacent property owner is interested in purchasing the ROW for \$9,375. Additional documentation is needed before Council will be able to take action on this agenda item.

Motion by Councilmember Sánchez to continue agenda item G5 to a future Regular Council Meeting; second by Councilmembers Bravo. Motion passed unanimously on a voice vote 6-0.

Councilmembers voted unanimously to *continue to a future Regular Council Meeting* consideration of a resolution authorizing the sale of Town-owned excess right-of-way. The right-of-way measures 50 feet by 25 feet and operates as a driveway for the adjacent property located at 9000 South Avenida del Yaqui. If approved, the adjacent property owner at 9000 South Avenida del Yaqui would pay the Town of Guadalupe \$9,375 to take ownership of the property, as stated in the Right of Way Agreement (C2021-52). The sale would comply with Arizona Revised Statues sections §28-7205 and §28-7208 declaring the property to be excess, approving the abandonment, and that compensation be paid to the Town.

#### 6. CITY OF PHOENIX INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT (RESOLUTION NO. R2021.18)

Mayor Molina stated that this agenda item is to consider adoption of a resolution authorizing the Mayor, or designee, to enter into an intergovernmental agreement with the City of Phoenix, on and behalf of the Phoenix Fire Department. The purpose of this agreement (C2021-51) is to authorize the Phoenix Fire Department to provide Town of Guadalupe Fire Department personnel fire service training. The term of the agreement shall be for five-years, until August 12, 2026, or until terminated by formal act of the parties.

Jeff Kulaga, Town Manager / Clerk, stated that this intergovernmental agreement (IGA) is for a new program for the Phoenix Fire Department to provide a variety of fire personnel training services to local jurisdictions.

Wayne Clement, Fire Chief, stated that the IGA was initiated by the City of Phoenix and is being offered to all municipalities in the Valley. The IGA is a standard agreement that outlines costs, requirements, and training options.

In response to questions, Mr. Clement stated that Guadalupe does not have any formal training agreements with any other local jurisdictions. Staff anticipates pursuing IGA's for fire training services with the cities of Chandler, Tempe, Mesa, and Gilbert, all of which have regional training facilities. Fees



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Motion by Councilmember Bravo to approve agenda item G6; second by Vice Mayor Vital. Motion passed unanimously on a voice vote 6-0.

Councilmembers adopted **RESOLUTION NO. R2021.18** authorizing the Mayor, or designee, to enter into an intergovernmental agreement with the City of Phoenix, on and behalf of the Phoenix Fire Department. The purpose of this agreement (C2021-51) is to authorize the Phoenix Fire Department to provide Town of Guadalupe Fire Department personnel fire service training. The term of the agreement shall be for five-years, until August 12, 2026, or until terminated by formal act of the parties.

#### 7. TOWN EMPLOYEE PAID HOLIDAYS (RESOLUTION NO. R2021.19)

Mayor Molina stated that this agenda item is to consider adoption of a resolution authorizing staff to amend the Town of Guadalupe Personnel Rules and Policies Manual to add four paid Town employee holidays as follows: New Year's Eve Day, the Monday following Easter, Juneteenth (June 19), and Christmas Eve Day; and, that Town Hall shall be closed for business on all Town holidays.

Jeff Kulaga, Town Manager / Clerk, stated that staff is recommending amending the Personnel Rules and Policies Manual to add four additional Town paid employee holidays. The four holidays are:

- Monday following Easter
- Juneteenth (June 19)
- Christmas Eve Day
- New Year's Eve Day

If approved, the Town would have 17 paid employee holidays. Per the League of Arizona Cities and Towns, Guadalupe would have a higher amount of paid holidays compared to other cities and towns in Arizona. However, Guadalupe's pay scale is significantly lower than other cities and towns in Arizona.

A Councilmember voiced support of approving the four additional holidays and acknowledged the low employee pay scale.

Motion by Vice Mayor Vital to approve agenda item G7; second by Councilmember Osuna. Motion passed unanimously on a voice vote 6-0.

Councilmembers adopted **RESOLUTION NO. R2021.19** authorizing staff to amend the Town of Guadalupe Personnel Rules and Policies Manual to add four paid Town employee holidays as follows: New Year's Eve Day, the Monday following Easter, Juneteenth (June 19), and Christmas Eve Day; and, that Town Hall shall be closed for business on all Town holidays.

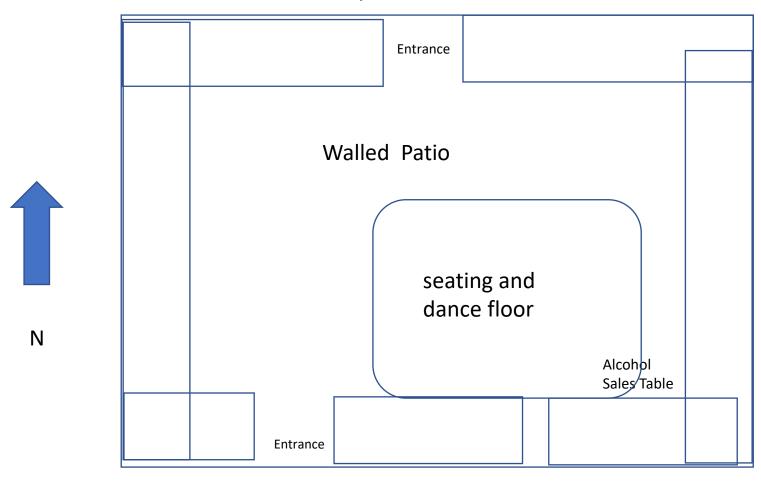

#### INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT

BETWEEN
THE STATE OF ARIZONA
AND
THE TOWN OF GUADALUPE

THIS AGREEMENT is entered into this date \_\_\_\_\_\_\_, pursuant to the Arizona Revised Statutes ("A.R.S.") §§ 11-951 through 11-954, as amended, between the STATE OF ARIZONA, acting by and through its DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (the "State" or "ADOT") and the TOWN OF GUADALUPE, acting by and through its Mayor and Town Council (the "Town"). The State and the Town are collectively referred to as "Parties."

#### I. RECITALS

- 1. The State is empowered by A.R.S. § 28-401 to enter into this Agreement and has delegated to the undersigned the authority to execute this Agreement on behalf of the State.
- 2. The Town is empowered by A.R.S. § 9-240 to enter into this Agreement and has by resolution, a copy of which is attached and made a part of, resolved to enter into this Agreement and has authorized the undersigned to execute this Agreement on behalf of the Town.
- 3. The improvements proposed in this Agreement, include the design and construction of sidewalk and bike lane on Avenida del Yaqui, northbound and southbound, between Highland Canal and Calle Carmen, (the "Project"). The Project includes mill and overlay of the full roadway cross section of existing asphaltic concrete pavement and complete reconstruction of the concrete curb, gutter and sidewalk along both sides of the corridor. The corridor improvement will also include new pavement markings and added bicycle facilities. Enhanced pedestrian crossings and amenities, traffic calming features and Safe Routes to School improvements will be installed. The Project includes removal and replacement of all existing traffic control signs along the length of the Project boundary. The State will administer the design and advertise, bid and award the construction phase of the Project.

4. The interest of the State in this Project is the acquisition of federal funds for the use and benefit of the Town and authorization of such federal funds for the Project pursuant to federal law and regulations. The State shall be the designated agent for the Town for the Project, if the Project is approved by Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and funds for the Project are available.

**THEREFORE**, in consideration of the mutual terms expressed in this Agreement, it is agreed as follows:

#### **II. SCOPE OF WORK**

#### 1. The Parties agree:

- a. The Project will be performed, completed, accepted and paid for in accordance with the requirements of the Project plans and specifications.
- b. The final Project amount may exceed the initial estimate(s) identified in Exhibit A, and in such case, the Town is responsible for, and agrees to pay, any and all actual costs exceeding the initial estimate. If the final bid amount is less than the initial estimate, the difference between the final bid amount and the initial estimate will be de-obligated or otherwise released from the Project. The Town acknowledges it remains responsible for, and agrees to pay according to the terms of this Agreement, any and all actual costs exceeding the final bid amount.
- c. The Town and ADOT will each separately file a Notice of Intent (NOI) under the Construction General Permit (CGP) with the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) before construction begins, if applicable to the Project.

#### 2. The State will:

- a. Execute this Agreement, and if the Project is approved by FHWA and funds for the Project are available, be the Town's designated agent for the Project.
- b. After this Agreement is executed, and prior to performing or authorizing any work, invoice the Town for the initial Project Development Administration (PDA) costs and the Town's share of the Project design costs, estimated at \$32,205.00. If PDA costs exceed the estimate during the development of design, notify the Town, obtain concurrence prior to continuing with the development of design, and invoice as determined by ADOT and the Town for additional costs to complete PDA for the Project. After the Project costs are finalized invoice or reimburse the Town for the difference between actual costs and the amount the Town has already paid for PDA.
- c. After receipt of the PDA costs and the Town's estimated share of the Project design costs, on behalf of the Town, prepare and provide all documents pertaining to the design and post-design of the Project, incorporating comments from the Town, as appropriate. Review and approve documents required by FHWA to qualify the Project for and to receive federal funds. Perform tasks that may consist of, but are not limited

to, preparation of environmental documents; analysis and documentation of environmental categorical exclusion determinations; geologic materials testing and analysis; right-of-way related activities; preparation of reports, design plans, maps, specifications and cost estimates and other related tasks essential to the development of the Project.

- d. Submit all required documentation pertaining to the Project to FHWA with the recommendation that the maximum federal funds programmed for this Project be approved for design. After receipt of FHWA authorization, proceed to advertise for and enter into contract(s) with the consultant(s) for the design and post design of the Project. Should costs exceed the maximum federal funds available it is understood and agreed that the Town will be responsible for any overage.
- e. After completion of design and prior to bid advertisement, invoice the Town for the actual PDA costs, as applicable, and the Town's share of the Project construction costs, estimated at \$169,216.00. After the Project costs for construction are finalized, the State will either invoice or reimburse the Town for the difference between estimated and actual costs. De-obligate or otherwise release any remaining federal funds from the design phase of the Project.
- f. After receipt of the actual PDA costs, if applicable, and the Town's estimated share of the Project construction costs, submit all required documentation to FHWA with the recommendation that the maximum federal funds programmed for construction of this Project be approved. Should costs exceed the maximum federal funds available, it is understood and agreed that the Town will be responsible for any overage.
- g. After receipt of FHWA authorization, proceed to advertise for, receive and open bids award and enter into a contract with the firm for the construction of the Project. If the bid amounts exceed the construction cost estimate, obtain Town concurrence prior to awarding the contract. After the Project is awarded, invoice the Town for the difference between estimated and actual costs, if applicable.
- h. Notify the Town of substantial completion and final acceptance of the Project. At such time, file a Notice of Termination (NOT) with ADEQ transferring CGP responsibilities to the Town, and provide a copy to the Town indicating that the State's maintenance responsibility of the Project is terminated, as applicable.
- i. Notify the Town of substantial completion and final acceptance of the Project; coordinate with the Town and turn over full responsibility of the Project improvements.
- j. Not be obligated to maintain the Project, should the Town fail to budget or provide for proper and perpetual maintenance as set forth in this Agreement.

#### 3. The Town will:

- a. Designate the State as the Town's authorized agent for the Project.
- b. Within 30 days of receipt of an invoice from the State, pay the initial PDA costs and the Town's share of Project design costs, estimated at \$32,205.00. Agree to be responsible

for actual PDA costs, if during the development of design, PDA costs exceed the initial estimate. Be responsible and pay for the difference between the estimated and actual PDA and design costs of the Project within 30 days of receipt of an invoice.

- c. Review design plans, specifications, cost estimates and other such documents required for the construction bidding and construction of the Project, including design plans and documents required by FHWA to qualify projects for and to receive federal funds; provide design review comments to the State as appropriate.
- d. After completion of design, within 30 days of receipt of an invoice from the State and prior to bid advertisement, pay to the State, any outstanding PDA costs and the Town's share of the Project construction costs, estimated at \$169,216.00. Be responsible for and pay the difference between the estimated and actual construction costs of the Project, within 30 days of receipt of an invoice.
- e. Be responsible for all costs incurred in performing and accomplishing the work as set forth under this Agreement, that are not covered by federal funding. Should costs be deemed ineligible or exceed the maximum federal funds available, it is understood and agreed that the Town is responsible for these costs; payment for these costs shall be made within 30 days of receipt of an invoice from the State.
- f. Certify that all necessary rights-of-way have been or will be acquired prior to advertisement for bid and also certify that all obstructions or unauthorized encroachments of whatever nature, either above or below the surface of the Project area, shall be removed from the proposed right-of-way, or will be removed prior to the start of construction, in accordance with The Uniform Relocation Assistance and Real Property Acquisition Policies Act of 1970 as amended; 49 CFR 24.102 Basic Acquisition Policies; 49 CFR 24.4 Assurances, Monitoring and Corrective Action, parts (a) & (b) and ADOT Right of Way Procedures Manual: 8.02 Responsibilities, 8.03 Prime Functions, 9.06 Monitoring Process and 9.07 Certification of Compliance. Coordinate with the appropriate State's Right-of-Way personnel during any right-of-way process performed by the Town, if applicable.
- g. Certify that the Town has adequate resources to discharge the Town's real property related responsibilities and ensures that its Title 23-funded projects are carried out using the FHWA approved and certified ADOT Right of Way Procedures Manual and that they will comply with current FHWA requirements whether or not the requirements are included in the FHWA approved ADOT Right of Way Procedures Manual. (23 CFR 710.201)
- h. Not permit or allow any encroachments on or private use of the right-of-way, except those authorized by permit. In the event of any unauthorized encroachment or improper use, the Town shall take all necessary steps to remove or prevent any such encroachment or use.
- i. Automatically grant to the State, by execution of this Agreement, its agents and/or contractors, without cost, the temporary right to enter Town rights-of-way, as required, to conduct any and all construction and preconstruction related activities for the

- Project, on, to and over said Town rights-of-way. This temporary right will expire with completion of the Project.
- j. Investigate and document utilities within the Project limits; submit findings to ADOT determining prior rights or no prior rights; approve an easement within the final right-of-way to re-establish the prior right location for those utilities with prior rights.
- k. Be obligated to incur any expenditure should unforeseen conditions or circumstances increase Project costs. Be responsible for the cost of any Town requested changes to the scope of work of the Project, such changes will require State and FHWA approval. Be responsible for any contractor claims for additional compensation caused by Project delay attributable to the Town. Payment for these costs will be made to the State within 30 days of receipt of an invoice from the State.
- After notification of final acceptance by the State, assume and maintain full
  responsibility of the Project, including Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plans (SWPPP)
  inspections, maintenance, and required documentation, until final stabilization is
  reached. Provide the NOI number to the State and the Contractor, accept CGP
  responsibilities at time of transfer, and file an NOT with ADEQ when final stabilization is
  reached, as applicable.
- m. After completion and final acceptance of the Project, agree to maintain and assume full responsibility of the Project and all Project components.
- n. Pursuant to 23 USC 102(b), repay all federal funds reimbursements for preliminary engineering costs on the Project if it does not advance to right of way acquisition or construction within 10 years after federal funds were first made available.

#### **III. MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS**

- 1. This Agreement shall become effective upon signing and dating of the Determination Letter by the State's Attorney General.
- 2. Any change or modification to the Project will only occur with the mutual written consent of both Parties.
- The terms, conditions and provisions of this Agreement shall remain in full force and effect until completion of the Project and all related deposits and/or reimbursements are made. Any provisions for maintenance shall be perpetual, unless assumed by another competent entity.
- 4. This Agreement may be cancelled at any time prior to the award of the Project contract and after 30 days written notice to the other Party. It is understood and agreed that, in the event the Town terminates this Agreement, the Town shall be responsible for all costs incurred by the State up to the time of termination. It is further understood and agreed that in the event the Town terminates this Agreement, the State shall in no way be obligated to complete or maintain the Project.

- 5. The Town shall indemnify, defend, and hold harmless the State, any of its departments, agencies, officers or employees (collectively referred to in this paragraph as the "State") from any and all claims, demands, suits, actions, proceedings, loss, cost and damages of every kind and description, including reasonable attorneys' fees and/or litigation expenses (collectively referred to in this paragraph as the "Claims"), which may be brought or made against or incurred by the State on account of loss of or damage to any property or for injuries to or death of any person, to the extent caused by, arising out of, or contributed to, by reasons of any alleged act, omission, professional error, fault, mistake, or negligence of the Town, its employees, officers, directors, agents, representatives, or contractors, their employees, agents, or representatives in connection with or incident to the performance of this Agreement. The Town's obligations under this paragraph shall not extend to any Claims to the extent caused by the negligence of the State, except the obligation does apply to any negligence of the Town which may be legally imputed to the State by virtue of the State's ownership or possession of land. The Town's obligations under this paragraph shall survive the termination of this Agreement.
- 6. The State shall include Section 107.13 of the 2008 version of the Arizona Department of Transportation Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction, incorporated into this Agreement by reference, in the State's contract with any and all contractors, of which the Town shall be specifically named as a third-party beneficiary. This provision may not be amended without the approval of the Town.
- 7. The cost of design, construction and construction engineering work under this Agreement is to be covered by the federal funds programmed for this Project, up to the maximum available. The Town acknowledges that actual Project costs may exceed the maximum available amount of federal funds, or that certain costs may not be accepted by FHWA as eligible for federal funds. Therefore, the Town agrees to pay the difference between actual costs of the Project and the federal funds received.
- 8. Should the federal funding related to this Project be terminated or reduced by the federal government, or Congress rescinds, fails to renew, or otherwise reduces apportionments or obligation authority, the State shall in no way be obligated for funding or liable for any past, current or future expenses under this Agreement.
- 9. The cost of the Project under this Agreement includes indirect costs approved by FHWA, as applicable.
- 10. The Parties warrant compliance with the Federal Funding Accountability and Transparency Act of 2006 and associated 2008 Amendments (the "Act"). Additionally, in a timely manner, the Town will provide information that is requested by the State to enable the State to comply with the requirements of the Act, as may be applicable.
- 11. The Town acknowledges and will comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act Of 1964.
- 12. The Town acknowledges compliance with federal laws and regulations and may be subject to the CODE OF FEDERAL REGULATIONS, TITLE 2, PART 200 (also known as The Uniform Grant Guidance). Entities that expend \$750,000.00 or more (on or after 12/26/14) of federal assistance (federal funds, federal grants, or federal awards) are required to comply by having an independent audit in accordance with §200.331 Subpart F. Either an electronic

or hardcopy of the Single Audit is to be sent to Arizona Department of Transportation Financial Management Services within the required deadline of nine months of the sub recipient fiscal year end.

- 13. This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with Arizona laws.
- 14. This Agreement may be cancelled in accordance with A.R.S. § 38-511.
- 15. The Town shall retain all books, accounts, reports, files and other records relating to the Agreement for five years after completion of the Project. These documents shall be subject at all reasonable times to inspection and audit by the State. Such records shall be produced by the Town at the request of ADOT.
- 16. This Agreement is subject to all applicable provisions of the Americans with Disabilities Act (Public Law 101-336, 42 U.S.C. 12101-12213) and all applicable federal regulations under the Act, including 28 CFR Parts 35 and 36. The Parties to this Agreement shall comply with Executive Order Number 2009-09 issued by the Governor of the State of Arizona and incorporated in this Agreement by reference regarding "Non-Discrimination."
- 17. Non-Availability of Funds: Every obligation of the State under this Agreement is conditioned upon the availability of funds appropriated or allocated for the fulfillment of such obligations. If funds are not allocated and available for the continuance of this Agreement, this Agreement may be terminated by the State at the end of the period for which the funds are available. No liability shall accrue to the State in the event this provision is exercised, and the State shall not be obligated or liable for any future payments as a result of termination under this paragraph.
- 18. In the event of any controversy, which may arise out of this Agreement, the Parties agree to abide by arbitration as is set forth for public works contracts if required by A.R.S. § 12-1518.
- 19. The Parties shall comply with the applicable requirements of A.R.S. § 41-4401.
- 20. The Parties shall certify that all contractors comply with the applicable requirements of A.R.S. §35-393.01.  $^{\rm 1}$
- 21. The Parties shall comply with all applicable laws, rules, regulations and ordinances, as may be amended.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> In *Jordahl v. Brnovich et al.*, Case No. 3:17-cv-08263 (D. Ariz.), the U.S. District Court entered a preliminary injunction that enjoins the State from enforcing A.R.S. § 35-393.01(A) (the "Anti-Israel Boycott Provision"). That statute states that: "[a] public entity may not enter into a contract with a company to acquire or dispose of services, supplies, information technology or construction unless the contract includes a written certification that the company is not currently engaged in, and agrees for the duration of the contract to not engage in, a boycott of Israel." Unless and until the District Court's injunction in *Jordahl* is stayed or lifted, the Anti-Israel Boycott Provision (A.R.S. § 35-393.01(A)) is unenforceable and the State will take no action to enforce it.
