


- Must be eligible member of current phase and provide appropriate identification at site
- Book and Schedule Vaccination Appointment in minutes
- Create Multiple Appointments for your Family Members.
- Keep your Data Confidential on our Secure Servers.




## Guadalupe COVID19 Weekly Positive Cases


Town of Guadalupe – Specific data – COVID19 Hospitalizations

June 7, 2020 – March 3, 2021




