MEETING MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING OF THE TOWN OF GUADALUPE COUNCIL

A public meeting of the Town of Guadalupe was held on **WEDNESDAY**, **APRIL 26**, **2017**, **AT 1:00 P.M.**, in the Council Chambers.

The agenda is as follows:

- A. CALL TO ORDER: Mayor Valarie Molina
- B. ROLL CALL: Absent were Councilmembers Valenzuela, Vital and Osuna.
- C. INVOCATION/PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE: Councilmember Cota.
- D. DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION ITEM:
 - 1. The Mayor and Town Council met with Deputy Daniel Beck from the Maricopa County Sherriff's office to discuss past and current events in Town. The Council discussed with Deputy Beck the recent car show event and suggested that in the future that Avenida del Yaqui be closed instead of Guadalupe Road. It was noted that the static displays were more than had been expected. Deputy Beck reported that he was concerned with specific event attendees who created unusual commotion and therefore called in additional deputies. The sheriff's department had understood the event would be completed by 6:00 pm, the event organizers had expected it to close at 6:30. The deputies began closing the event at 7:20. At 8 pm, security was no longer needed.

Deputy Beck provided information to council members regarding security for the event and reviewed this report with Council. Vice Mayor Cota asked if the deputies noticed open containers of beer beyond the contained area. Deputy Beck observed that a motor cycle group had set up a booth. It was noted that those people drinking alcohol should have been wearing wrist bands but this had not been set up by the sponsor of the alcohol sales. Deputy Beck mentioned that there were more people at the event than in previous years. It was noted that The Mint (medical marijuana store) also had a booth at the event. It was also noted that town staff attended the event in the past.

E. ADJOURNMENT: Vice Mayor Cota mad a motion seconded by Councilmember Cota that the meeting be adjourned. Motion carried. 2:15 PM
