1. Multi-Purpose Athletic Turf Field – Presentation by representatives of the East Valley Boys and Girls Club.

Ramon Elias, CEO of the East Valley Boys and Girls Club reported the project would cost approximately \$790,000 and \$700,000 had been identified and \$100,000 line of credit was approved by Chase Bank. He said the lighting, playground and basketball court will be installed in phase II.

Mayor Jimenez stated the town engineers did not review the plans before the building permit was issued by the town manager. Town engineers received the plans for review on the 23rd and found eleven items of concern relating to drainage that needed to be addressed before a permit would be issued. The engineers scheduled a site visit for the following Friday. Mayor Jimenez directed the town manager to advertise to the public that plans for field be on display at town hall and announce it on the digital marquee.
