Alma Vital Johnson, representing the Guadalupe/Tempe Little League will request approval of Resolution 2017-16 authorizing the Town to submit a grant request to the Arizona Diamondbacks Foundation for funding of little league park improvements and supplies. Council will review the grant request for funding and possibly approve this project as a pass through grant.
4. Maria Hernandez, representing the Marcos De Niza marching band will present the activities of the band and request a contribution for the band from the Town.
5. Discussion and planning for the annual Christmas parade and related activities. Deputy Beck will be present from the Sherriff's Department to provide information on this event.
6. Council May consider cancelling regular meeting on August 24th and may consider scheduling a Special Meeting.
7. Council will discuss possible appointment of an advisory board to review applications for the Town Manager and make recommendations to the Town Council.
