Town of Guadalupe Requires the Use of Face Coverings in Public

Guadalupe, AZ - In response to the [Governor's June 17, 2020 Executive Order](#), today the Town of Guadalupe's Mayor Valerie Molina issued a proclamation requiring face masks be worn in all places of public accommodation within the Town of Guadalupe to assist in mitigating the spread of COVID-19. State and Federal public health experts have stated face coverings — cloth masks that cover the mouth and nose — are effective in limiting the spread of the coronavirus.

Presently, the Town of Guadalupe is experiencing a COVID-19 positive case rate that is four times the rate of Maricopa County, according to the Maricopa County Public Health Department. "The number of COVID-19 cases in Guadalupe is of growing concern" stated Mayor Valerie Molina, "it is critical to the health of our community that we take further steps to reduce the spread of the virus by wearing face coverings and practice physical distancing. I am calling on every person in our Town to wear a face covering to help reduce our Town's positive case rate and more importantly, protect our family's health, your Moms, Dads, Aunts, Uncles and Grandparents."

To help Guadalupe residents comply with requirement, face coverings are available for a limited time. Residents who do not have access to face coverings will be able to pick up a face mask in the Town Hall lobby during COVID-19 business hours of Tuesdays from 9 AM to 12 PM and Wednesdays from 2 PM to 5 PM. The Town of Guadalupe is committed to doing what we can to mitigate the transmission of COVID-19.
