1. **PUBLIC HEARING** Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Fiscal Year 2017-2018.
The Town of Guadalupe will conduct a public hearing for the purpose of allowing maximum feasible citizen involvement in the planning of specific H.U.D. Community Development Block Grant projects. She asked when the funds will be available to the Town should the grant be approved.
